This agreement provides important details of the band program such as important dates, Fair Share Fees and payment due dates, expectations, contact information and more. It is important that both you and your parent(s) and/or guardian(s) read through this agreement in its entirety. In order for us to have a successful season this agreement must be understood and agreed upon by both students and parent(s) and/or guardian(s). **This agreement must be <u>signed</u> by both the student and the parent(s) and/or guardian(s) and turned into Mr. Acevedo prior to the start of band camp. Please only return the signature page, keep the other pages for future reference.**

The Ironwood Band Community Foundation (IBCF) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. The purpose of the Ironwood Band Community Foundation is to financially and physically support the music program of Ironwood High School and to accelerate the development of music students in its Band Community.

#### FEES

There is a fee to be in marching band. The Fair Share Fee this year is \$350.00.

Your student's Fair Share Fee covers items that are exclusive to them. These items include, but not limited to, their water jug, backpack, show shirt, shoes and uniform. The band has many expenses above and beyond the items listed here. A few of these expenses are music, props, additional staff for student instruction, U-hauls and fuel for competitions and our equipment – instruments, flags and sound gear. Please keep in mind that our program is not funded by the district or school. The Fair Share Fee's we collect cover roughly half the cost of our program to operate, the balance depends on heavy fundraising, private donations and sponsorships from businesses within our community.

**FEE DUE DATES** – It is imperative that all fees are received at the start of our program as that is when most of our expenses are due. If you are unable to make the payments by the date due, please promptly reach out to the IBCF to setup a payment plan. Unpaid fees can potentially affect future participation in the band program.

First Payment - \$200.00 Due on July 19th, 2024

Second Payment - \$150.00 Due on August 30th, 2024

In addition to the Fair Share Fee the school also charges a Student Athletic Participation Fee of \$100.00 and an Equipment Fee of \$50.00. These fees are due at the beginning of the season and should be paid to the bookstore no later than August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024. This is a district requirement; no exceptions can be made by the Band Director. These fees DO NOT apply towards your Fair Share Fee. Remember to take advantage of the Arizona State Tax Credit when paying your \$100.00 Student Athletic Participation Fee. Please see the school's website for the forms and to answer any questions you may have regarding the tax credit. (The Arizona State Tax Credit can NOT be used to pay your student's Fair Share Fee).

#### PHYSICALS – DUE BY JULY 16<sup>TH</sup>, 2024

All students are required to have a sports physical prior to the start of band camp. YES, marching band is considered a sport! This is a district requirement; no exceptions can be made by the Band Director. The links to Register My Athlete can be found on Ironwood High School's website. Please allow enough time for processing your registration by the school prior to the start of band camp.

#### **EXPECTATIONS**

GRADES – Ironwood has a No pass, No Play policy. Students must maintain a passing grade in order to participate in extracurricular activities. Grades are checked by teachers each Friday. If the student has a failing grade, they will receive a "Red Card". Receiving a Red Card means the student is not eligible to participate in the following week's game and/or event. If the student brings their grade up to passing before the event happens, the teacher can clear the student to participate.

ATTENDANCE – We expect all students to be in attendance and be on time for every rehearsal, football game and competition! If you are involved in other school activities, we are willing to work with you on scheduling. Of course, we understand emergencies happen. If you are unable to attend any of the scheduled rehearsals or events, please notify your Section Leader and your Band Director in a timely manner. We expect there to be thorough communication between students, parents and instructors.

#### ETIQUETTE

- Marching band is hard work, yet a ton of fun! We expect everyone to maintain a positive attitude and be ready to learn.
- Be respectful at all times, to everyone, including yourself! Respecting all of your instructors, staff, and band mates is a top priority. All of our band volunteers are to be shown the same respect as everyone else. Remember our volunteers are also a vital part of our band. Our program is intended to be a safe and comfortable environment for all of our students and staff.

Inappropriate behavior will **NOT** be tolerated and will result in an appropriate consequence.

 All students are expected to follow Ironwood's rules and expectations as outlined in the Student Handbook. You can find the Student Handbook on the school's website for more information regarding school rules, regulations, and policies.

#### **INSTRUMENTS AND EQUIPMENT**

All students are responsible for their instrument(s) and/or equipment – this includes all Color Guard equipment as well. You are solely responsible for any fees associated with loss, damage, repair or replacement associated with your instrument(s) and/or equipment. You are solely responsible to checkout instruments and/or equipment from the Band Director before using said items for other extracurricular activities outside of our program. Once the instrument(s) and/or equipment he school grounds it is your complete responsibility.

#### REFUNDS

Band Participation Fees become nonrefundable after our show costumes, equipment and supplies have been ordered. Please keep in mind our costumes are designed specifically for our show and custom fitted for each student. Once our order has been placed with the vendor(s) we can't cancel it, therefore no refunds can be issued to the student. Any refunds that may be issued prior to our costume, equipment and supplies order(s) will be refunded by check or refunded back to the card used for payment. Please note credit/debit card processing fees will not be refunded.

#### DISNEYLAND

Every spring the band students have an opportunity to take a school trip to Disneyland. In order to be eligible to go to Disneyland the Fair Share Fee of \$350.00 must be paid in full.

#### VOLUNTEERS

The IBCF is always looking for helping hands. We have several different volunteer opportunities throughout the marching season. Please reach out to the IBCF if you are able to lend a hand to any (or all of our events). Parent help is much appreciated and always needed to make our band program successful.
